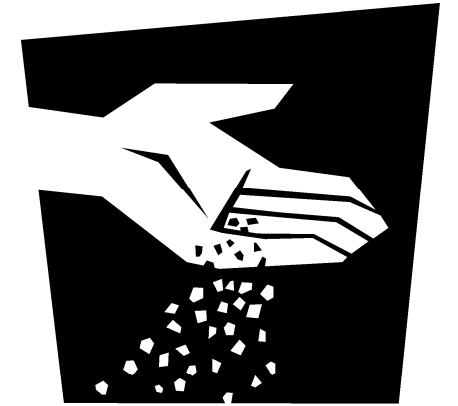
Sympathy
